Admission Requirements for 2026 TOCFL sprint class

I. The Purpose of The Program

In order to encourage Chinese-learning students to participate in the TOCFL test and to help students pass their test level, MTC provides an online refresher class before the test. It is encouraged that students in Taiwan and overseas are in need can prepare for their exams through these online courses.

II. Admissions Features

- 1. Instructors have many years of experience, and have deep knowledge of the TOCFL questions: including the types of questions typically asked and possible correct answers. Instructors will conduct mock tests in the course based on this knowledge.
- 2. The course features interactive, face-to-face, online learning and course allows students to learn from their teachers in real-time.
- 3. The target applicants: Students intending to take the TOCFL test Band A or Band B. Expected enrollment: 10 students.
- 4. Since the exam is for different levels (Band A, Band B, and Band C), we combine Band A and Band B into one class. During this class, there will be content for both A-level and B-level students.
- 5. Since this is a sprint class, the teacher will not spend much time emphasizing grammar and vocabulary but will focus on doing practice questions continuously to familiarize you with the exam format.
